

# KEEP YOUR MEDS TO YOURSELF

## If you share medications:

- You may put someone at risk for negative consequences ranging from nausea and disorientation, to blackout, to detox, or even death.
- You may be held liable if something negative happens to your friends/family members
- It is illegal to “distribute” medications to another person if you are not licensed to do so

## If you take or buy medications without a prescription:

- When you get medication from somewhere other than a pharmacy, you can't be sure what is in it.
- You may be unaware of how the medication should be used, such as proper dosage, risks of mixing with alcohol, or signs of allergic reaction.
- It is illegal to “possess” medications not obtained directly with a valid prescription.

Possessing or distributing an illegal substance is a **violation of the WSU student conduct code** and **conviction on a drug offense** may jeopardize your ability to get federal financial aid.
